The reality is that 1 in 7 Australians are living in poverty, with 1 in 6 children affected. That's 2.9 million Australians too many. This year all money raised will support UnitingCare programs for people living in crisis. They may be suffering from homelessness, abusive relationships, addictions, financial hardship, illness or sudden crisis.

"As poverty levels rise across Australia, it's important that communities pull together to support those around them who need it most," says Marie Howard Senior Manager of UnitingCare in Victoria and Tasmania.

"UnitingCare Pancake Day is a fantastic opportunity to bring people together for a fun day while supporting the work of UnitingCare."

Now in its 16th year, UnitingCare Pancake Day aims to raise \$100,000. Shrove Tuesday, 28 February is the official Pancake Day, but events can be held at any time throughout February and March.
